Sydenham Tennis Club - Special Recognition Award ('SRA')

<u>Purpose of SRA award:</u> to recognise especially outstanding service by volunteers or staff at the Club over a long period of time

Main factors to consider :-

The SRA award is to recognise a candidate who

- 1. Has made an exceptional contribution to the Club for several years.
- 2. Has been instrumental in opening up tennis and/ or squash, racketball or pickleball, or other activities at the Club to enable more people to play and enjoy these sports
- 3. Has shown excellent teamwork or leadership
- 4. Has demonstrated an outstanding consideration of diversity, inclusion and safeguarding
- 5. Has contributed significantly to the provision of sports and improved facilities at the club.

Points to note:

- The SRA award is open to volunteers and paid staff of the Club.
- The award will only be awarded if there is a candidate who has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to the Club over a long period of time.
- The award is to be considered each year but no award will be granted at all in a year unless there is a deserving candidate.
- If there is more than one suitable candidate, then more than one award can be made each year.
- It is not necessary to meet all of the criteria above to obtain the SRA award; other factors can also be considered
- Anyone who has received Volunteer of the Year Award or the VRA award is eligible for the SRA award as well as volunteers or staff who have not received a previous award of any kind.
- It is only possible for any individual to receive the SRA award on one occasion.
